St Andrew's is the Anglican Church in Chelmondiston, a village on the Shotley Peninsula. The first records we know of to do with Chelmondiston Church are of a Rector instituted on 1266. That makes it more than likely that there has been a church building here since well before that time.

Of the building that stood here since the Middle Ages not an awful lot is left. On the evening of 10th December 1944 it was destroyed by a doodle bug that had gone astray. Our wonderful current building was finished in 1957. The church is open during the day and you are welcome

to come in and pray, look around or simply sit and find some peace and quiet.
